

ORDINANCE 2017- 05

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 50-6 OF
THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "SPECIAL LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS."**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Bay Head, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter §50-6 of the Code of the Borough of Bay Head, entitled, "Special Law Enforcement Officers," is hereby amended and supplemented so as to revise §50-6, so as to read in its entirety as follows:

Section 50-6 Special Law Enforcement Officers

- A. Special Law Enforcement Officers shall be authorized to perform all duties and responsibilities allowed to be performed as provided in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act, subject to the supervision and direction of the Police Chief. Special Law Enforcement Officers may be employed as either Class One and/or Class Two Special Law Enforcement Officers, as those classifications are established and described in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.8 et seq.
- B. The number of Class One Special Law Enforcement Officers hired by the Borough shall be at the discretion of the Police Chief but shall not exceed ten Class One Special Law Enforcement Officers. Class One Special Law Enforcement Officers shall meet all the requirements and terms for appointment and continued employment which are set forth in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act.
- C. The number of Class Two Special Law Enforcement Officers hired by the Borough shall be at the discretion of the Police Chief but shall not exceed ten Class Two Special Law Enforcement Officers. Class Two Special Law Enforcement Officers shall meet all the requirements and terms for appointment and continued employment which are set forth in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
