

ORDINANCE 2020 08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 222 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, ENTITLED "PARKING," SO AS TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 222-3, ENTITLED "CERTAIN PARKING PROHIBITED," TO CREATE CHAPTER 222-3(C) TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Bay Head, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.**

CHAPTER 222-3 (C), entitled "Parking on Private Property Prohibited," shall read as follows:

Parking on Private Property Prohibited.


- a. Parking within the Borough of Bay Head on private property without the owner's or lawful occupant's consent shall be a violation of this section.
- b. For any violation of this provision of this section, the fine shall not exceed five hundred (\$500) dollars nor be less than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.
- c. In designating the violation of this section as a payable offense, the municipal court is hereby authorized to include a violation of this section on the "Local Supplemental Violations Bureau Schedule" pursuant to R. 7:12-4(c) of the New Jersey Court Rules.
- d. The Borough of Bay Head Police Department is charged with enforcing the provisions of this chapter.


**SECTION 2.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**SECTION 3.**


This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
