

ORDINANCE 2015-14

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING
AND SUPPLEMENTING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 222,
ENTITLED, “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Bay Head, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Bay Head is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend § 222-14 of Chapter 222, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” so as to read in its entirety as follows:

Chapter 222. VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

§222-14. Regulations.

No person shall:

- A. Park any motor vehicle in any portion of the Municipal Parking Lot except within a designated parking space.
- B. Park any motor vehicle in any parking space within the Municipal Parking Lot which is marked, in some manner, for restricted or designated use unless authorized.
- C. Park any motor vehicle in the spaces within the Municipal Parking Lot more than four hours in any one day. Trailers, recreational equipment, campers, or mobile homes may be parked in the rear of the public parking lot adjacent to Centennial Park for a 48 hour period.

SECTION 2. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Bay Head is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend § 222-20 of Chapter 222, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” so as delete all references to Club Drive in § 222-20 entitled, “Schedule II: Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets.”

SECTION 3. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Bay Head is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend § 222-21 of Chapter 222, entitled “Vehicles and Traffic,” so as to add to §222-21 entitled, “Schedule III: Parking Time Limited On Certain Streets,” the following provision:

Club Drive	Both	2 hour 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. every day	From Bridge Avenue in a northerly direction along Club Drive to a point 160 feet.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent

jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
