

ORDINANCE 2015-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BAY HEAD, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 50-6, ENTITLED "SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS."

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Bay Head, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 50-6 of the Municipal Code of the Borough of Bay Head, entitled "Special Law Enforcement Officers," is hereby amended as follows:

Section 50-6 -Special law enforcement officers shall be authorized to perform all duties and responsibilities allowed to be performed as provided in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act, subject to the supervision and direction of the Police Chief. Special law enforcement officers may be employed as either Class One and/or Class Two special law enforcement officers, as those classifications are established and described in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.8 et seq.

There shall be no more than four Class One special law enforcement officers. Class One special law enforcement officers shall meet all the requirements and terms for appointment and continued employment which are set forth in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act.

There shall be no more than six Class Two special law enforcement officers. Class Two special law enforcement officers shall meet all the requirements and terms for appointment and continued employment which are set forth in the Special Law Enforcement Officers Act.

SECTION 2.If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3.This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
